RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION Steade Craigo, FAIA

WHEREAS, Steade R. Craigo, FAIA, began his historic preservation career working at the local level in the field of Historic Preservation for the City of Charleston, South Carolina and served as a Trustee for the Historic Charleston Foundation; and,

WHEREAS, after receiving his graduate degree in historic conservation studies from the University of York, England, Mr. Craigo began working at the California Office of Historic Preservation, California State Parks during November of 1977; and,

WHEREAS, during his years of service at the Office of Historic Preservation, Mr. Craigo held many positions and performed numerous duties in the Office, including serving as California's first Restoration Architect and First Senior Restoration Architect, acting as grants reviewer for National Parks Service bricks and mortar projects, performing Federal Tax Act and Federal 106 project reviews; representing the California State Parks for 24 years on the California Historical Building Safety Commission; and,

WHEREAS, during his tenure at the Office, Mr. Craigo served as California's Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer and also served for three years as Acting State Historic Preservation Officer and Executive Secretary to the California Historical Resources Commission, and later as grants manager for Proposition 12 historic preservation grant program and as coordinator of the California Main Street Program; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Craigo's exceptional service to the field of historic preservation includes serving as first Chief of the former Cultural Resources Division, California State Parks, serving on the Board of Trustees for the California Preservation Foundation, serving on the City of Sacramento Preservation Design Review Board, serving on the Board of Directors of the National Conference of State Historic Preservation Officers, and serving on the Board of Trustees for the United States Committee of the International Council on Monuments and Sites; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the State Historical Resources Commission extends its highest commendation and recognition to Mr. Craigo for his thirty two years of dedicated service to the people of State of California and to the Commission; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the State Historical Resources Commission and the staff members of the Office of Historic Preservation wish Mr. Craigo continued good health and happiness during his retirement in the years to come; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the State Historical Resources Commission and a suitable copy presented to Mr. Craigo.
