Submission Guidelines: *California Archaeology* welcomes submission of original manuscripts. All manuscripts are subject to anonymous peer review by knowledgeable scholars and professional practitioners and, if accepted, may be subject to revision. Materials submitted to *California Archaeology* should not be under consideration by other publishers, nor should they be previously published in any form. Submissions should include an original manuscript in MSWord or RTF format sent electronically to CaliforniaArchaeology@calpoly.edu. with an accompanying e-mail message identify the manuscript as an ARTICLE, REPORT, LETTER, or REVIEW. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the style guide for American Antiquity (including the Spanish abstract) which is available at <http://www.saa.org/Publications/StyleGuide/styframe.html>. Tables should be sent collected together in a separate file in either MS Word or Excel format. Figures should be sent as 300 dpi TIFs, 5 inches wide, each in a separate file. Articles are limited to 30 double-spaced pages (12 pt Times Roman) including references, figures, and tables. Reports are limited to 12 pages. Letters and responses are limited to 350 words and no more than 6 references. Reviews are limited to 1000 words. Exceptions to this style policy are: (1) page margins for text should 1.25 inches for manuscripts submitted to *California Archaeology*, and (2) tables should be single-spaced and supplied in a separate file. Final decisions on all publications will be made by the Editor, who reserves the right to return manuscripts that do not meet expectations or that fail to conform to these guidelines. The review process generally takes two to four months. Authors will be notified as soon as decisions are reached to reject or accept a paper.
